SPECIAL COLLECTIONS – NOVEMBER 2024

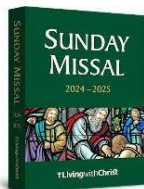
We have two important collections in November. The first is for the priests' retirement fund that is on the weekend of **November 10th**. Our priests have spent their working lives running our parishes. They have provided us with spiritual guidance and counseled us as we go through life. This archdiocesan fund is to assist those retired priests who need financial assistance.

The Food Bank Collection is on the weekend of **November 17th**. The money collected in St. Mary's, Odessa is given to the Partners in Mission Food Bank that serves Amherstview and Kingston. The money collected in St. Patrick's, Railton goes to the Southern Frontenac Community Services Corporation (SFCSC) food bank in Sydenham that services the South Frontenac area. This collection is in cooperation with the Knights of Columbus Food for Families program. The Knights contribute an extra \$100 for every \$500 collected locally up to a maximum contribution of \$500. Please give generously as the use of food banks is increasing."

Confirmation registration is now open.

A mandatory parent meeting will take place on **Sunday, November 17th, 2024**, following the 11:00am Mass (approximately at 12:15pm) in the St. Patrick Church building. If you are not able to be there on that day the same meeting content will take place on **Tuesday, November 26th, 2024** at 7:00 pm in St. Patrick Parish Hall. These meetings won't be longer than 30 minutes.

The meeting will consist of an outline of the program that will be used as well as encouraging you to be supportive of your child and to try your best to be interested in what she or he is doing by participating in preparation for Confirmation. I will also outline the component of parish participation.

If you have a child who has made their first Communion and first Reconciliation and is in grade 7 or 8 or later, it is time to complete their process of being a full member of the Catholic Church. Parents who want to enroll their child for the Sacrament of Confirmation can go to the parish website and download the Registration Form. **You are asked to fill in the required information and include a copy your child's Catholic Baptismal Certificate and bring them to the Parent meeting.**

Please take time to help your child to form a deeper relationship with Jesus. I invite you and your family to participate at Sunday Mass at 11:00am at St. Patrick in Railton or on Saturday at 4:30pm at St. Mary in Odessa on a regular basis. Gathered to worship God as a parish community is the strongest connection to your faith life since it is where the Holy Spirit leads us as the Body of Christ and helps us to grow with others in our relationship with Jesus.

A great benefit for you as a parent is that you will have a spiritually strong bond with your child. It may be a good opportunity for you to learn more about your faith as well since you will be directly involved!

If you and your family attend another parish other than St. Patrick or St. Mary, and you want to celebrate Confirmation there you can contact the Parish Priest of your parish to find out what is involved to prepare for the Sacrament at that parish. Hope to you see at our meeting.

A Knight's Saint's Corner. *Saint Marie-Leonie Paradis* [1840-19912], she is the third Catholic Saint beside *St. Marguerite d'Youville* and *St. Brother Andre*

Bessette born in Canada. Not too long ago I wrote about Blessed Mother Marie-Leonie for my former Parish in Sudbury and now it is with great joy to follow up with her canonization on October 20th.

With fourteen she joined the Congregation of the Holy Cross, made her vows in 1857 and became a teacher. In 1862 sent to teach in religious communities in the USA but was called back twelve years later to St. Joseph's College in Memramcook, NB. There in 1880 under her leadership a community for *The Little Sister of the Holy Family* was formed; the Sisters served and supported in numerous houses diocesan clergy and diverse religious communities. Saint Marie-Leonie showed a great desire of love and need for support of priestly ministries, practiced obedience and servitude all according to Jesus our Saviour.
